

## **Sermon Discussion Questions for Small Groups & Families**

*Revelation 12:1 – 13:1*

1. Martin Luther thought he saw the devil in his study one day and threw an inkwell at him. Have you ever had an experience like that? Would you be willing to talk about it?
2. How has the devil accused you? What has he accused you of?
3. “When we accuse others, we play right into our accuser’s hands.” How do you react to this statement? In what ways is this true in your own life?
4. Why are the devil’s attempts to consume the Child so central to the history of the world?
5. Pastor Stan suggested that the woman is likely the community of God’s people throughout the ages. Do you agree? If not, why not? If so, why is she depicted as huge and glorious?
6. How has Jesus definitively answered the devil’s accusations? What does that mean to you?
7. How is the second half of 12:12 related to John’s sour stomach in chapter 10?
8. 12:11 harkens back to chapter 11. Why did the “two witnesses” have to die?
9. How do *you* deal with the fury of the devil and his demons, especially in light of the chapters 10-11?
