

Sermon Discussion Questions for Families & Small Groups

- Do you ever struggle when it comes to sharing your faith with others? What fears and insecurities get in the way? How and when were you able to overcome them?
- Discuss some of the changes in American culture since 1960 that have impacted the way we share our faith with others. Talk about the 1-10 scale Pastor Bill used in his sermon. Talk about where some of your unsaved loved ones, co-workers and neighbors might be on that scale.
- Has your witnessing ever been motivated by anything besides love? If so, what happened?
- Think about two or three people in your life who are non-believers. What doubts do they have? What is keeping them from embracing Jesus as their Lord and Savior? How does/should that impact the way you witness to them?
- How consistent is the way you live with what you profess to believe? In what ways can you improve your credibility by purifying your witness?
- Who is God calling you to share your faith with right now? Who can keep you accountable to praying for them, loving them and listening to them? What opportunities might you have upcoming to spend time together? What opportunities might you have upcoming to invite them to experience the gospel with you?
